Single Super spread over approximately 70 % of the property in September 2019. A mixture of timber on the property with some spectacular old growth trees which gives a good indication of the quality of the country.

Water; Very much a feature of this property with an 8 km double frontage to the Cooplacurripa River. Numerous smaller creeks on the property and an abundance of springs. Approximately 16 dams. High rain fall country recorded on farm at an average of 44.5 inches (1,112.5 mm)

Livestock operations and potential; Bridlevale is a great breeding or backgrounding block for cattle. Bridlevale is located in a tightly held area due to the consistency of the rainfall in the area and the heavy rich basalt soil types. The owner estimates a carrying capacity of approximately 200 to 250 cows and calves. For those who love mountain grazing country, this property is a must to inspect.
