Supporting the main retail area are practical back-of-house facilities, including a kitchenette, storage room, two changing rooms, and a powder room, creating a functional environment for day-to-day operations. Further enhancing accessibility, the property benefits from off-street parking for two vehicles and valuable rear lane access via Centenary Drive.

Offered to the market with vacant possession, this is an outstanding opportunity for owner-operators seeking a prominent business address, or investors looking to secure a high-profile commercial asset in one of the Northern Rivers' most tightly held townships.

Often compared to the relationship between Bangalow and Byron Bay, Maclean continues to benefit from its close connection to nearby Yamba while maintaining its own distinct character and strong local economy. A stroll through the town centre reveals a vibrant mix of established retailers, cafes, and professional services, underpinning ongoing demand and long-term growth prospects.
