Downstairs living is generous and easy, with high ceilings, tiled dining for low-fuss meals and a lounge that handles all seasons — slow combustion fire for winter, split system and fans for summer. Just off the lounge room there sits a study nook which be easily opened up to extend the scope of the lounge. The kitchen is light-filled and practical, with wide views across the property so you can keep an eye on the bush while the kettle boils.

Upstairs, the main bedroom is a seriously large retreat. Not just a place to sleep, but a space you can truly make your own. There's room for a creative studio, a library corner, a sitting area — or all three if you're ambitious. It opens onto the balcony, delivering sweeping views over the valley and surrounding bushland, plus moonrises that don't need a filter. On clear nights, the stars and planets put on a show — a private view of the cosmos without leaving your balcony. Private, peaceful and a very good reason to linger upstairs longer than planned.

The second bedroom is cleverly set up with its own entrance, ensuite, air conditioning and even a sink, making it ideal for guests, teenagers or anyone who values independence. There's also a constant-temperature cellar — wine storage, "everything" storage, or a naturally cool hideaway when summer decides to show off.
