A well formed network of access trails winds throughout the property, following elevated ridgelines and linking multiple prime building sites. From these commanding positions, enjoy sweeping valley views, cooling coastal breezes and spectacular sunrises and sunsets across an ever changing natural landscape. The sense of elevation and outlook is truly special, offering a range of potential homesites that combine privacy with breathtaking aspect.

For those seeking to create an eco retreat or nature based tourism venture (STCA), the scale and topography provide outstanding versatility. The mix of ridges, sheltered gullies and native forest creates a serene environment ideal for cabins, glamping sites or a wellness sanctuary immersed in nature. Guests would feel a world away, yet remain within easy reach of Coffs Harbour's airport, restaurants and coastline.
