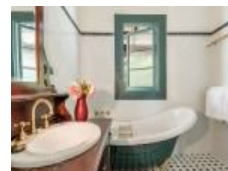
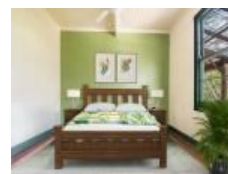

The rustic cottage - one of the region's few remaining original Railway cottages - is not only spacious but also light filled and airy, designed to capture the cool summer breezes, the home features high ceilings, timber flooring and a north-easterly facing deck, offering a seamless flow between outdoors and in.

The home has an ambience of a country escape, with all the conveniences of modern living.

The large kitchen offers an abundance of bench and storage space, while ceiling fans compliment the natural ventilation of the home.

The spacious bathroom features stained glass windows and a claw foot bath and shower.

Upstairs, there are three bedrooms, and attic, ideal for guest room, childrens playroom, or that extra storage much needed for documents, suit cases and Christmas decorations. In addition, downstairs provides a separate rumpus room and art room ideal for the hobby enthusiast or home office, in addition a shower and toilet and storeroom are a welcome addition.

A large under covered entertaining area on the ground floor is spacious and cool, and offers yet another outdoor living space, perfect for al fresco entertaining, table tennis, billiards and the like.

Separate to the home is a 9m x 9m shed/studio, with a toilet and shower. This studio can be used for a variety of purposes.
